Facilities

Toilet facilities: available 400m away in Rowntree Park

Car parking: available at Butcher Terrace field near Millennium Bridge

Prizes

We will have many individual, annual and team trophies, medals and race certificates.

Following the race we have a BBQ and prize giving. There are a large range of prizes covering single and double kayaks, Canadian canoes, paddle boards and teams, in all three race distances.

We ask for donations towards the BBQ - pay what you can afford.

Prize winners are restricted to 1 trophy only (excluding annual trophies).

Teams are 3 paddlers in same course from the same organisation, the team name must be declared on entry form.

Safety Regulations - IMPORTANT

Leaders please convey to all your paddlers.

- Competitors must keep right of the river centre throughout the course.
- All bridges must be crossed via the right hand archway (nearest to the bank).
- Look out for passing motorboats when turning.
- All competitors must wear buoyancy aids.
- All boats must clearly display the race bib & number.
- Anyone who is a full on-the-water member of British Canoeing or is an Associate Member through membership of an Affiliated Club is insured to enter the event.
- Anyone who is not covered as above will have to pay £5 for a day ticket

3 minute time penalties will be added for any infringement of these safety regulations

Whilst safety canoes will be in attendance and a thorough risk assessment has been carried out canoeing is an adventure sport and you take part at your own risk.

Car Parking

Car parking at Butcher Terrace field near Millennium Bridge. Please be aware that parking here is at your own risk.

Directions: Enter York on Bishopthorpe Road via A1, A64 or A19. Follow signs for York Racecourse. 400 metres further north from Terry's former factory take a right on to Butcher Terrace. The nearest postcode is YO23 1LS.

CAUTION: A gate will be opened so competitors can park on the grass near the start. This parking area is public space. Drive carefully, watch out for cyclists and pedestrians.
